Lola Olufemi's Statement

Read by Laura Schwartz of Feminist Fightback

I want to start by saying that I was looking forward to being in conversation with everyone today, and to meet the feminist academics and organizers that have created a legacy of knowledge to draw on. I believe feminism is a political methodology that we can use to make demands for our freedom and the freedom of others, and woman is an umbrella term under which we can gather to make those demands. It's a strategy for those of us on the underside of capital and other death-making machines. It has no meaning to me absent of that function. The reason I withdrew from this panel is because it's clear the organizers had not done enough to investigate speakers' links to Woman's Place UK – a clearly transphobic organization - or to ensure that members of this group would not be in attendance/disrupt proceedings which I have seen happen time and time again. Trans exclusionary radical feminist networks cut across universities, public instructions [institutions?] and women's services. I have seen first-hand how white middle class women with social capital have used their gatekeeping power to harass trans people, threaten them with defamation, actively work to curtail their rights, refused to extend solidarity, and then claim victimhood. I am uninterested in attending feminist events or conferences that do not take a clear stance against this attempt to hijack feminism or allow these networks to exist unchallenged. I don't have time to unpick what I find so abhorrent about the second wave resurgence of calls for sex-based rights, this ideology's links to the alt right, scientific racism, and how it has poisoned chances for intergenerational conversation and distracted us from the most pressing and urgent fact - that our material conditions as women, and all those read as women, are steadily deteriorating. Sex and the body are not the final frontier for me. My imagination is bigger than that. My liberated future includes us all. It is not beholden to a rigid sex binary. And my solidarity is not dependent on chromosomes. I want to end by urging members of the audience to resist this imposed culture war and to practice a feminism that recognises that trans liberation is central to our collective liberation, especially for anyone interested in abolishing gender and its violent consequences.

She has no time to actually explain why believing in sex is an 'abhorrent' thoughtcrime that women must be comprehensively bullied out of by using

She won't actually sit down and have a conversation with anyone about why it is in the interests of people who are oppressed on the basis of sex to

<u>@selina\_todd @womenslib\_50 @lolaolufemi\_@Womans\_Place\_UK</u> comply with the political erasure of the axis of their own oppression. She won't do that because were she to participate in that conversation it would become absolutely evident that this patriarchy-vanishing crap falls apart under the merest hint of intellectual interrogation.

<u>@selina\_todd @womenslib\_50 @lolaolufemi\_@Womans\_Place\_UK</u> Instead, like so many of generational colleagues, she will use smears, guilt by association, lies, hyperbole, threats, and exert power to shut other women down. If she really is merely 'uninterested' in engaging in conversation with women who hold a different analysis to her,

<u>@selina\_todd @womenslib\_50 @lolaolufemi\_@Womans\_Place\_UK</u> then she is welcome to not attend events where such women are present, though she will find that if we are treated with mutual recognition and respect, we are \*very\* interested in discussing this question in a manner which vaguely resembles the behaviour fitting of members of

But actually Lola is not 'uninterested' in the slightest. Rather, Lola is \*very\* interested in ensuring that women who do not hold her analysis are expelled from the movement that we have participated in and nourished for decades of our lives.

<u>@selina\_todd @womenslib\_50 @lolaolufemi\_@Womans\_Place\_UK</u> Because Lola believes that only her vision of the world is correct. That because sex-based analysis does not serve the political interests of non-female people that it must be expunged from thought and from history. That this is allegedly in the interests of female people.

<u>@selina\_todd @womenslib\_50 @lolaolufemi\_@Womans\_Place\_UK</u> And that female people who do not agree or comply must be compelled to do so in a manner which is - hahahafuckingha - in the interests of social 'justice.'

This totalitarian bullshit and bullying has to fucking stop. You have derailed an entire conference dedicated to

are not female in female people's politics. You have done so in the most manipulative, authoritarian and underhand manner. You do not have the right to dictate to women who have

<u>@selina\_todd @womenslib\_50 @lolaolufemi\_@Womans\_Place\_UK</u> dedicated their lives to thinking, speaking, researching, fighting, lobbying and providing services to women that their voices are 'hateful' and their interests illegitimate because they understand that we are oppressed on the basis of our sex, and because we will not comply with

<u>@selina\_todd @womenslib\_50 @lolaolufemi\_@Womans\_Place\_UK</u> your totalitarian demand that we pretend otherwise, or turn feminism into a political movement that teaches women precisely what patriarchy has always taught them, that they are not allowed to centre their own needs, and they are bad and evil and selfish for doing so.

<u>@selina\_todd @womenslib\_50 @lolaolufemi\_@Womans\_Place\_UK</u> If you don't want to do activism that centres female people then fine, go and do some other type of activism. But the female liberation movement is the only fucking place in the world where female people are allowed to place themselves front and centre. And we will not allow you

<u>@selina\_todd @womenslib\_50 @lolaolufemi\_@Womans\_Place\_UK</u> turn it into a massive exercise in performing female socialisation for the benefit of non-female people.

If you want to talk to us, come and talk. We want to talk. But if you don't, please, for the love of the goddess, stop being such a fascist and fuck off.

<u>@selina\_todd @womenslib\_50 @lolaolufemi\_@Womans\_Place\_UK</u> I'm also going to add. Lola was the main instigator of the walk-out at the FWSA conference last autumn. So, coercion of women's speech is not a new fancy of hers. The way Julia Long framed her comment is not one I would entirely endorse, and I don't think it is helpful, but

First, Ruth Pearce launched across the room incredibly aggressively, and then Lola spoke from the platform demanding Julia be expelled, and then when Julia refused to leave, encouraged the entire room to walk-out until Julia had been escorted out.

First, I went basically to have a look at the state of academic feminism. Unlike our opponents, I believe it is important to actually hear what people you

heard was a lot of people talking about race, and disability, and neoliberalism, and queering time, and pretty much fuck all about the oppression of women. This is what happens to

<u>@selina\_todd @womenslib\_50 @lolaolufemi\_@Womans\_Place\_UK</u> feminism when intersectionality ceases to mean 'think about how other axis of oppression intersect with sex' and becomes 'think about other access of oppression and btw believing women exist as a sex-class is a thoughtcrime.' Lo, if you don't centre women in feminism, feminism

<u>@selina\_todd @womenslib\_50 @lolaolufemi\_@Womans\_Place\_UK</u> ceases to be about women... and what political movement is then doing to work of articulating female people's interests and opposing male power...? Nobody. How fucking convenient. Little wonder males love intersectional feminism.

Second, women like Lola actually have no

They have never ever done us the decency of actually looking at our work or our words, and have, rather, just sucked up the propaganda from trans activists without an iota of critical thought.

Not one single person in a room of over 100 academic

Maybe there were women there who know that Woman's Place is run by socialist feminist women from a trade union background who have an impeccable record of left-wing organising. I knew that, but in a room full of women who have been fed trans activist propaganda for half a decade, I wasn't going to say anything, and given what happened when Julia spoke, that assessment was evidently correct.

Ruth Pearce, btw,

Ruth Pearce was the person who came onto twitter the day after the attack on Maria Maclachlan and proudly announced that they had made sure none of the TRA orgs denounced the attack. (Sidenote: I told one of

FACTS BEFORE YOU SILENCE EVIL WOMEN HEY ACADEMIC FEMINISM???]) I have seen emails sent to academic feminist listserves by

they should think about it, full of the usual hyperbole and lies and smears and terrible analogies and emotional blackmail with which we are so painfully familiar.

Which Lola has just so perfectly articulated in front of a conference of women assembled to celebrate 50 years of the women's movement, while pointing an entirely unsubstantiated finger at women she actually KNOWS FUCK ALL ABOUT.
