Women, thinking they have the right to organise and meet and have rights as a sex class = genocide

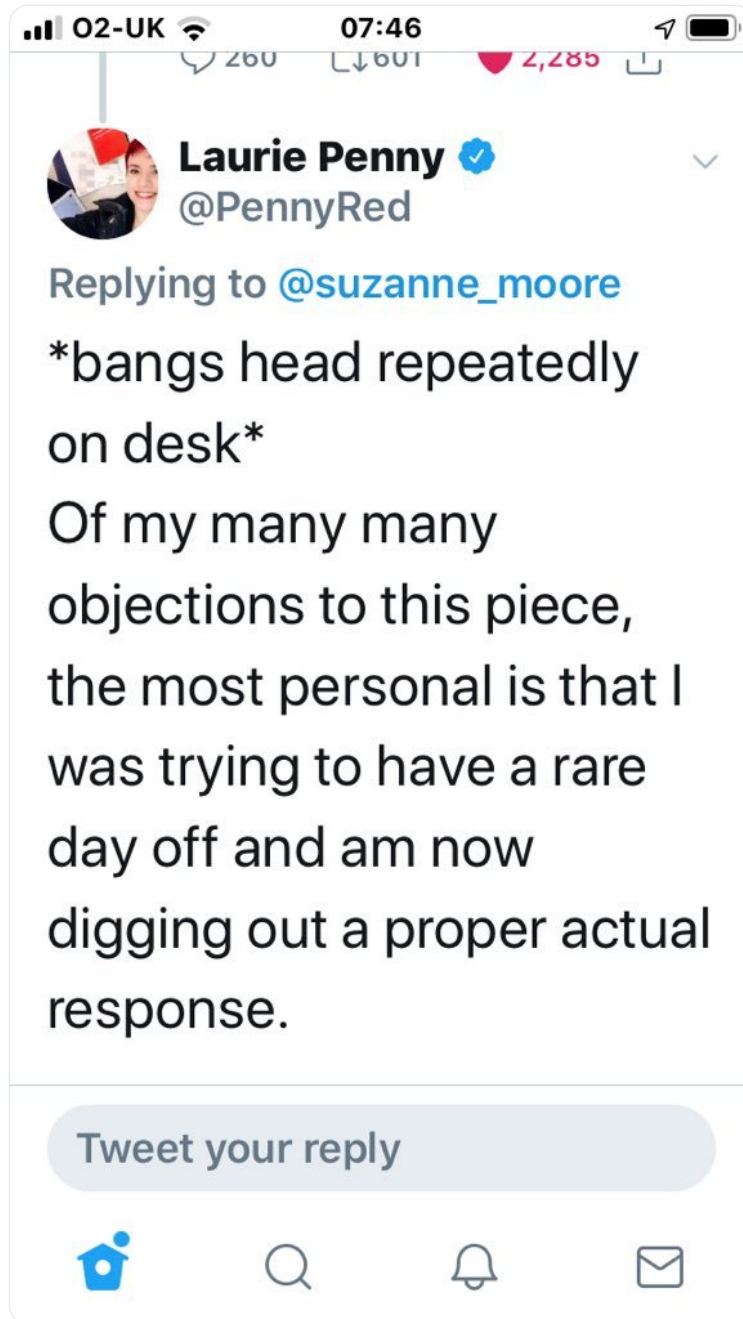
If you hang your whole political project on removing those rights from women, it's YOUR. FUCKING. PROBLEM.

Notes for Laurie.

1. No emotional blackmail
2. No hyperbolic statistics or claims
3. No blaming women for male violence against trans people
4. No amorphous manipulative claims about safety
5. No bullshit analogies comparing women who want to maintain their rights to racists,

Nazis, genocidal tyrants

6. Based on actual material reality
7. Allows for the possibility that not everyone agrees with nonsense about spectrums, clownfish, and colonial invention of gender binaries
8. Has an adequate account of why female people are

oppressed

9. Has an adequate way of dealing with the thought that gender is a system which has arisen to oppress female people plus other gender non conforming people

10. Explains why we should believe that people's feelings about their gender changes material reality

11. Explains why gender identity ideology doesn't re-enforce the relation between sex and gender.

12. Explains why women should accept

a) the redefinition of the political class to which they belong without being consulted and without their consent

b) the refusal of their rights

to organise as a sex class and the rights given to them as a sex class

13. Explains why removing these rights from women doesn't constitute an attack on women's rights they might legitimately resist

14. Explains how allowing male people into female people's spaces in an entirely

unregulated way doesn't constitute a potential danger to women without handwaving the feminist analysis of male violence

15. Addresses the fact that women who have objected to this political agenda have been subjected to the most totalitarian campaign of bullying, harassment,

no-platforming, threatening of livelihood etc, and explains how the fuck you manage to carry on thinking you are on the side of women while you pretend that this isn't happening and suggest in fact we are nasty bitches for pointing it out.
