What you really thought of those men that men use in women's spaces. Men calling themselves women, Kristina Jane Harrison, said that he was a lesbian, he said it to me.

So you have to totally acknowledge the reason these horizontal attacks come is because they couldn't hold a goddamn line. They refused. They offered you a hard pass measure. They offered you tepid water when you wanted a soaking hot bath. That's what they did. That's why now when we are winning, and we are winning on the basis that we speak the truth we speak clearly we don't pull our punches, we are not afraid. And the reason that works is cuz it's honest. The reason I sometimes say things which some of you may not like is because I don't filter my words in case I'm not going to speak the truth. I don't filter my words in case something hateful comes out because I don't feel particularly hateful. The love I feel for women and girls and the solidarity and protection I feel for all women and girls irrespective of whether or not they agree with me. It's so absolute resolute that I don't I'm not afraid of what I'm going to say. It's why I'm okay to talk to anybody at any point.

I can talk to people that that I may not choose to talk to some other people I've talked to before. And that's basically because I didn't do my research. I didn't do my research because the guy in Canada, he'd interviewed Lindsey Shepard. Now I thought if he's interviewed Lindsey Shepherd, who I think is a courageous young woman who like myself came from the left, then he can't be all that bad. He must be a disgruntled lefty. Turns out he wasn't. I went to a far-left conference in Norway that those women will tell you it was a far-right conference. It was full of communists and socialists. That's who was in that conference. It was by a whole load of lefties. In Norway, it was not a far-right conference wasn't hanging out with far-right people. I've never hung out with any far-right people never ever, to my knowledge have I hung out with anyone on the far right. Woman's Place UK have kept up a statement that they have used against me since they made it. They just make inferences and suggestions. And because of that I became a lone wolf. And I can honestly say I thank them for that. Because by being a lone wolf, it did make me more vulnerable to attacks. And I did get plenty of them. Thanks very much, including against my family and my children. But it also made me realize that if I want to do something, if I want to have a clear message, then it's best that I just speak for me. And if other people listening like it, then maybe they think I speak for them or certainly to them. It's just really, every now and again. And I must admit their audience gets smaller. But Woman's Place UK have never told anyone what the evidence is of their accusations or inferences.
